

How to Access Launchpad from Home

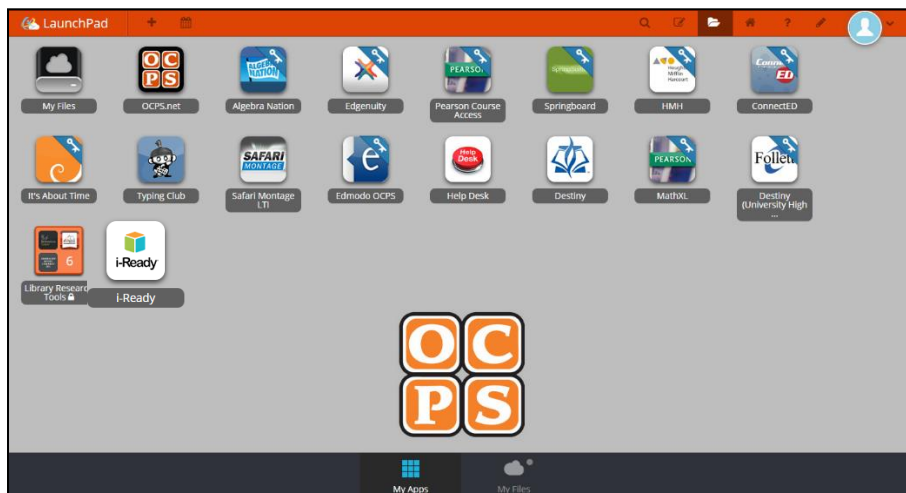
You may access Launchpad from any browser, however, if you're having functionality issues, Google Chrome is preferred.

- After you have opened your web browser, go to your settings.
- Ensure that your cookies are enabled and your pop-up blocker is disabled.
- Then go to the LaunchPad website found at launch.ocps.net.



How to Login:

- You have access to LaunchPad regardless if you are at school, at home, or on the go.
- Your user name is your OCPS student ID number.
- Your password is your birthday in YYYYMMDD format.
- Once your OCPS credentials are entered, click on either Sign-In or Auto Login to be directed to the LaunchPad Dashboard.



How to Access on Other Devices:

- If you are having trouble accessing LaunchPad from a computer, you can access LaunchPad from other devices:
- If accessing Launchpad from an iPhone, iPad, and iPod Touch, search OCPS Launch and download the free LaunchPad app from the App Store. **TO ACCESS IREADY THROUGH LAUNCHPAD SEE HIGHLIGHTED DIRECTIONS BELOW.**
- If accessing Launchpad from an Android phone or tablet, search Classlink or OCPS Launch in the App Store and download the free the LaunchPad app from Google Play. *To access iReady the browser you are using, needs to have Java.*
- If accessing Launchpad from the Internet on your phone, sign-in to Launch.ocps.net and click mobile in the bottom of the log-in screen.
- Regardless of the method used, your credentials will be the same as if you were logging in from your computer. If the school code is missing on the log-in screen, please enter OCPS.



- *****ACCESSING IREADY THROUGH LAUNCHPAD ON IPAD or IPHONE: This requires a few extra steps. The first thing you'll need to do is download a free browser from the Apple App Store called, Puffin. Once this browser is downloaded, open the browser. Go to the website launch.ocps.net. Then click the "G" Google icon. This will ask for a student's Google email account. Each student in OCPS has a Google email account. Their email address is: studentnumber@students.ocps.net and their current password (birthdate: YYYYMMDD). This will then launch LaunchPad and the student can click the iReady tile and begin their lessons.**

Trouble Shooting Tips:

- A server authentication pop-up box may appear.
- Your user name is your OCPS student ID number immediately followed by @ocps.
- Your password is once again your birthday in YYYY-MM-DD format.

- If you are using Internet Explorer, close the browser and reopen it; it will force authentication again with the OCPS login server.
